The Reporting Person undertakes to provide the Issuer, any security holder of the Issuer, or the staff at the Securities and Exchange Commission, upon request, the full information regarding the number of shares sold at each separate price within the ranges set forth above.
- 3. The price reported in column 4 is a weighted average price. These shares were sold in multiple transactions at prices ranging from \$64.87 to \$65.55. The Reporting Person undertakes to provide the Issuer, any security holder of the Issuer, or the staff at the Securities and Exchange Commission, upon request, the full information regarding the number of shares sold at each separate price within the ranges set forth above.
- 4. The price reported in column 4 is a weighted average price. These shares were sold in multiple transactions at prices ranging from \$65.89 to \$66.50. The Reporting Person undertakes to provide the Issuer, any security holder of the Issuer, or the staff at the Securities and Exchange Commission, upon request, the full information regarding the number of shares sold at each separate price within the ranges set forth above.
- 5. The shares are held of record by Kelly Steckelberg Trust dated July 29, 2006, for which the Reporting Person serves as trustee.
- 6. 1/4 of the shares subject to the option vested on November 6, 2018, and 1/48 of the shares vest monthly thereafter. The shares subject to this option are early exercisable, subject to the Issuer's right to repurchase.
- 7. Each share of Class B Common Stock is convertible at the option of the Reporting Person into one share of Class A Common Stock and has no expiration date. Each share of Class B Common Stock held by the Reporting Person will automatically convert into one share of Class A Common Stock upon (a) other than Eric S. Yuan, the death of the Reporting Person, or (b) any transfer by the Reporting Person except certain

"Permitted Transfers" described in the Issuer's certificate of incorporation. All outstanding shares of Class B Common Stock will convert into shares of Class A Common Stock upon the earliest of (i) six months following the death or incapacity of Mr. Yuan, (ii) six months following the date that Mr. Yuan ceases providing services to the Issuer, (iii) the date specified by the holders of a majority of the shares of Class B Common Stock, and (iv) the 15-year anniversary of the closing of the Issuer's initial public offering.

- 8. 1/48 of the shares subject to the option vests in equal monthly installments commencing one month from September 24, 2018. The shares subject to this option are early exercisable, subject to the Issuer's right to repurchase.
- 9. Each share of Class B Common Stock is convertible at the option of the Reporting Person into one share of Class A Common Stock and has no expiration date. Following the closing of the Issuer's IPO, each share of Class B Common Stock held by the Reporting Person will convert automatically into one share of Class A Common Stock upon (a) other than Eric S. Yuan, the death of the Reporting Person, or (b) any transfer by the Reporting Person except certain "Permitted Transfers" described in the Issuer's certificate of incorporation.
