All outstanding shares of Class B Common Stock will convert into shares of Class A Common Stock upon the earliest of (i) six months following the death or incapacity of Mr. Yuan, (ii) six months following the date that Mr. Yuan ceases providing services to the Issuer, (iii) the date specified by the holders of a majority of the shares of Class B Common Stock, and (iv) the 15-year anniversary of the closing of the Issuer's IPO.
